The Curtis Boys Lacrosse Booster Club is seeking donations for our fifth annual Crab Feed and Dinner Auction on March 24, 2012. We would like to ask that you assist us in our fundraising efforts this year in one or both of the following ways:

- DONATE *Any new/unused merchandise or service that can be auctioned or raffled off for fundraising purposes.*
- PROVIDE *Underwriting dollars for this year's event that can be used to purchase items for raffle or auction or used to assist in funding the dinner event. Underwriting can be for specific auction/raffle items or general in nature.*

Should you decide to donate, your business will be advertised in the event program and the team program. Your donations are tax-exempt and you will have the added benefit of receiving a charitable donation receipt. We are registered with the State of Washington as a Non-Profit Corporation and we have been granted 501(c) 3 statuses with the IRS (Curtis Boys Lacrosse Boosters Tax ID #20-8142297).

We are a volunteer non-profit organization with a mission to support the Curtis High School Boys Lacrosse program. Our program fields 2 teams and allows approximately 50 boys in grade 9 through 12 to continue playing what has been called the fastest growing sport in America. Many of these boys have aspirations of playing lacrosse at the college level and several from last season have gone on to do so! The Curtis Team has also fielded several All-State players in the past. Curtis High School is very supportive of our program and provides field usage, transportation and a coaching stipend for the head coach. Each player pays a fee to play unlike the varsity sports that are free.

As a Booster Club we raise funds for additional things the team needs. Funds that we raise go to pay coaching stipends for assistant coaches and JV coaches, as the time commitment for these positions is immense. These funds also help to purchase new uniforms, team travel, activities and equipment.

We believe that being involved in your community is also important, so the team does volunteer work as well. Last year we had several boys volunteer to help coach youth teams through the local youth program. Many of the players also volunteered at Adriana Hess Wetlands Park getting it ready for spring and summer visitors.
